Tour Itinerary



Friday, January 29, 2016

Individual departures from home airports to Houston, and check-in for the international flight to Rio de Janeiro. Dinner served on our overnight flight. (D**)

Saturday, January 30, 2016

Upon arrival in Rio de Janeiro, we meet our local English-speaking guide and transfer by private motor coach to the beachfront hotel for a two-night stay.

The afternoon is free to rest or explore on our own. Tonight we attend the *Plataforma Show*—an evening of Brazilian music, dance and folklore! (B, L, D)



Sunday, January 31, 2016

Today we enjoy a city tour of Rio de Janeiro, with sights including the Christ the Redeemer Statue, and the famed Maracana Soccer Stadium.

During the afternoon we visit Sugar Loaf Mountain and Tijuca Forest, and the Sambodromo. (B, L, D)



Monday, February 1, 2016

This morning we take a flight to Cuiaba, the capital city of the Mato Grosso state. Upon arrival, transfer to our hotel in the Pantanal, the world's largest tropical wetland area. This evening after dinner we have a night safari. (B, L, D)

Tuesday, February 2, 2016

This entire day is dedicated to discovering the Pantanal. During the morning we take a boat tour to observe nature and local flora and fauna. In the afternoon we will explore the area by horseback and on a walking trail. Later we drive to a Cuiaba hotel for dinner and overnight. (B, L, D)



Wednesday, February 3, 2016

This morning we meet with representatives of FAMATO, the Federation of Agriculture and Livestock of Mato Grosso, which is similar to the American Farm Bureau. We will get an overview of Brazilian agriculture and have a chance to share ideas. Then we drive to Lucas do Rio Verde, one of Brazil's major agricultural cities, with a visit to a grain farm en route. Here we have a two-night stay. (B, L, D)

Thursday, February 4, 2016

Today we visit the Dow Agrosiences crop research center in Sorriso, the world's largest producer of soybeans. In the afternoon we return to Rio do Lucas Verde to visit the JBS cattle feedlot, with a capacity for 25,000 head. (B, L, D)



Friday, February 5, 2016

After breakfast, we check-out and drive back to Cuiaba, with a stop in Nova Mutum where we visit a grain farm with an elevator. We take a flight to Foz do Iguacu, and then transfer to our hotel for overnight. (B, L, -)



Saturday, February 6, 2016

Today we will visit the Iguazu National Park and the Brazilian side of the Iguazu Falls. We will also see Itaipu Dam, one of the largest hydroelectric facilities in the world. Later we transfer to the airport for our flight home, with connections in Sao Paulo and Houston. (B, L)
